**Sarah Gardner** has initiated, written or led many affordable housing studies and plans. Here's a few...

2003: Redevelopment Plan for the Photech Site with the new town manager Peter Fohlin. The plan called for affordable housing using the block building and developing townhouses on the site, with a bike path through the site. This was the very first plan for the Photec site. 16 years later, affordable housing will be developed at the site.

2005: "Redevelopment Plan for the Delftree Mill" including plans for commercial development and affordable housing.

2009: "Revitalizing Williamstown's Superblock" is a plan to develop mixed-use commercial/affordable housing in townhouses on the Town Garage site.

2010: "Feasibility Study of the Wylde Property" An assessment of affordable housing potential on the Wylde property off North Hoosic Road.

2012: "Disaster Relief Housing Study" assessed various town sites for their potential for affordable housing development for displaced Spruces residents.
