If there is a line at the River Garden, on the way back to the Latchis or Marlboro, try the public restrooms at Sam's and at the Brattleboro Food Coop. If you park at the municipal garage on Flat Street, there are restrooms at street level, in the bus waiting room, southeast corner.
